COMMANDMENT 5 - VOLUNTEERS MUST HAVE OPPORTUNITIES TO GROW AND LEARN.

COMMANDMENT 6 - VOLUNTEERS MUST BE ENCOURAGED TO MAKE AS MANY DECISIONS AS POSSIBLE.

COMMANDMENT 7 - VOLUNTEERS WORK BEST IN A FRIENDLY, WARM ATMOSPHERE WHERE THEIR EFFORTS ARE OBVIOUSLY NEEDED AND APPRECIATED.

COMMANDMENT 8 - VOLUNTEERS MUST NOT BE TAKEN FOR GRANTED.

COMMANDMENT 9 - KEEP VOLUNTEERS INFORMED ABOUT DEVELOPMENTS IN THE ORGANIZATION.
