Executive Summary - CERT's services were requested for the Lake of the Ozarks Shootout to provide a first aid tent to relieve the first responders of calls by taking on the minor first aid calls during the shootout.

Assessment

Objective 1: Provide additional support for information and emergency situations for the public for the duration of the event.

Activities: Answer questions regarding where things are located, how to get help, and radio for additional requests as well as handling minor medical incidents.

Assessment: CERT performed perfectly in their role. On Saturday, the team handled 12 medical incidents, passing two of those off to EMS as more serious injuries than their training would allow them to handle. On Sunday, there were no medical incidents and the team answered questions about the location of things at the event.

Conclusion - CERT performed well, succeeding at their task of relieving the ambulance service of running minor first aid calls and allowing the ambulance

service to focus on more advanced medical calls. They also assisted event attendees in locating different aspects of the event.

Recommendations

1. Increase the types of signage available for CERT to use during events and emergencies.
