Executive Summary - CERT's services were requested for the Lake of the Ozarks Shootout to provide a first aid tent to relieve the first responders of calls by taking on the minor first aid calls during the shootout.

Assessment

Objective 1: Provide first-aid support for the event. If any situation were to go above CERT's threshold, CERT members in the first-aid tent would send it to the COMC bus or the Lake West ambulance on scene.

Activities: Handling minor medical incidents within CERT's training.

Assessment: CERT performed perfectly in their role. On Saturday, the team handled 19 medical incidents, passing 7 of those off to EMS and/or COMC as more serious injuries than their training would allow them to handle. On Sunday, there was 1 medical incident before the first-aid tent was packed away and the CERT trailer was moved out on account of rain. The location of the CERT first-aid tent was very good (near the entrance of Captain Ron's).

Conclusion - CERT performed well, working with COMC to minimize the number of first-aid calls that the ambulance service had to respond to.

Recommendations

1. Having the CERTs who are working the event get familiar with what's where in the bags
2. Table itself to have a tray setup for medical supplies instead of digging in the bags
3. Make sure that there are enough ratchet or non-ratcheting straps on the trailer to secure both tents simultaneously
4. Talk with the health department to get something that absorbs blood better than sand (Director Henley will speak with Stephanie about that)
5. Need new CERT tablecloth(s) because the last one became hazmat - one "pretty" one for shows and one for operations (ideally made of plastic/something else easy to decontaminate)
6. Need clarification ahead of time if the volunteers are going to be provided with meals or if CERT needs to make meal arrangements
7. When first responders or COMC arrive, CERT members and the patient's family need to back up to give the responders room to work
